RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 30

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH SOUTHERN CRESCENT TECHNICAL COLLEGE TO PROVIDE WELDING SKILLS INSTRUCTION FOR INMATES WITHIN CLAYTON COUNTY'S CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE MOU AS REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE MOU; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MOU; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, WorkSource Atlanta Regional of the Atlanta Regional Commission (ARC) has provided funding for local governments to provide welding training programs according to an approved curriculum and costs established by ARC; and

WHEREAS, Southern Crescent Technical College has instructors capable of leading welding training consistent with the guidelines established by ARC; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by equipping incarcerated individuals with a trade to assist them in becoming self-sufficient and reduce recidivism; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believes that it is in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will be best served by entering into a memorandum of understanding with Southern Crescent Technical College to provide welding instruction for inmates within Clayton County's correctional facilities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Southern Crescent Technical College to provide valuable welding skills for inmates within Clayton County, Georgia correctional facilities. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

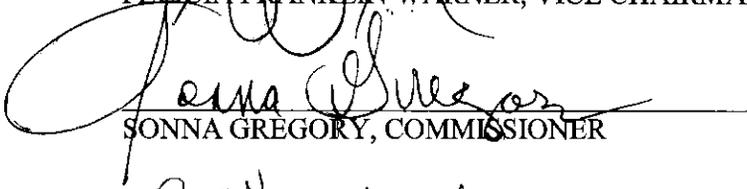

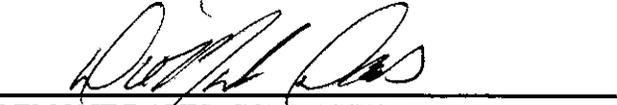
