RESOLUTION NO. 2019-47

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA TO PARTNER WITH THE AIRPORT SOUTH COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT TO IMPROVE WEST FAYETTEVILLE ROAD IN FRONT OF LAND LOTS 70 AND 71; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Airport South Community Improvement District ("ASCID") represents commercial and industrial property owners in portions of College Park in unincorporated Clayton County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, as part of the improvements of West Fayetteville Road (SR 314), Land Lots 70 and 71 require driveway cuts; and

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation has approved the driveway cut with an additional requirement of a five-foot sidewalk within the project limits; and

WHEREAS, the total cost for the improvements is \$150,000.00 of which the property owner will cover \$75,000.00. ASCID and the City of College Park have agreed to contribute \$25,000.00 each to cover the remaining costs for the property improvements to include sidewalk improvements; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by partnering with ASCID to provide \$25,000.00 towards the cost of the property improvements on West Fayetteville Road in front of Land Lots 70 and 71 to include sidewalk improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Clayton County Board of Commissioners hereby agrees to provide funding in the amount of \$25,000.00 towards property improvements on West


Fayetteville Road (SR 314) in front of Land Lots 70 and 71 to include sidewalk improvements.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense.


Section 3. The effective date of this Resolution shall be when approved by the Board of Commissioners of Clayton County.




