RESOLUTION NO. 2019-62

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA TO COLLABORATE WITH YOUTH FINANCIAL LITERACY FOUNDATION AND CLAYTON COLLABORATIVE AUTHORITY; TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY AND ITS DEPARTMENTS TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED UNDER THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, research has found that financial literacy habits that are formed at a young age can lead to key money habits that will benefit people for the rest of their lives; and

WHEREAS, the Youth Financial Literacy Foundation (“YFL”) has an award-winning Money Management Certification Program called FamilyMint consisting of a 60-page step-by-step workbook along with an online money management application which has a real world application designed to be completed by children in their homes; and

WHEREAS, FamilyMint is designed to increase student’s understanding, confidence and success in managing money and reinforcing topics relating to saving money, setting financial goals, delaying gratification, and budgeting, among other topics; and

WHEREAS, the County, through its Office of Youth Services and Department of Parks and Recreation, desires to collaborate with the Clayton Collaborative Authority and YFL in offering FamilyMint to Youth Commission candidates and 11-13 year old campers enrolled in the Parks and Recreation Department’s Summer Camp Program from June 3 – July 26, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into this collaboration.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Clayton County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes a collaboration between the Office of Youth Services, Department of Parks & Recreation along with the Clayton Collaborative Authority and The Youth Financial Literacy Foundation (YFL) to provide an eight (8) week free certification training from June 3,-July 26, 2019 to Youth Commission candidates and 11-13 year old campers enrolled in the Parks and Recreation Department's Summer Camp Program. YFL will provide all training materials and an instructor and will make a monetary donation via the Clayton Collaborative Authority for every child that completes the program.



The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense all as may be required by this Resolution.


Section 3. The effective date of this Resolution shall be when approved by the Board of Commissioners of Clayton County.






