RESOLUTION NO. 2019-92

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF JONESBORO PROVIDING FOR THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE CITY OF JONESBORO WILL BE ALLOWED USE OF COUNTY PROPERTY FOR A GARDEN; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET AS NEEDED TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County (“the County”) and the City of Jonesboro (“the City”)(collectively referred to as “the Parties”) desire to maintain a mutually beneficial, efficient and cooperative relationship that will promote the interests of the citizens of both jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the Parties to this Agreement are both governmental units; and

WHEREAS, the City is interested in launching a City Garden on property owned by the County located at 114 North Avenue, Jonesboro, Georgia (“the Property”); and

WHEREAS, the Property is not currently in use by the County, but has been improved to allow access to water on the Property; and

WHEREAS, the City has received expressions of interest and support for a garden from private entities such as Food Well Alliance and Atlanta Harvest and the City is seeking citizen participants for a planning committee to design and build the garden; and

WHEREAS, the Parties anticipate that, if the garden is designed and built on the Property, it will become a meeting place and another attraction for both city and county residents

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City for the reasons contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Jonesboro (the "City") providing for the terms and conditions under which the City will use property owned by the County located at 114 North Avenue, Jonesboro, Georgia for use as a City Garden. The agreement is attached hereto as "Attachment A". The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the agreement and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of the Resolution. The Board further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget as needed to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


