RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 108

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH CLAYTON STATE UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE WORK TO STUDENTS ELIGIBLE FOR FEDERAL WORK-STUDY PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE MOU AS REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE MOU; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MOU; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Federal Work-Study Program has provided funding for students to work off campus while simultaneously studying at an educational institution; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of Clayton State University seeks to enter into a memorandum of understanding with Clayton County, through its Fire and Emergency Services Department, for students to perform specific work assignments associated with emergency preparedness; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believes that it is in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will be best served by entering into a memorandum of understanding with Clayton State University to provide work opportunities for students to perform specific work

assignments associated with emergency preparedness.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF
COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners or his designee to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Clayton State University to provide work opportunities for students to perform specific work assignments associated with emergency preparedness. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


