RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 125

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY, ON BEHALF OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY SENIOR SERVICES DEPARTMENT, TO GRANT A SPECIAL FACILITY USE REQUEST TO ALLOW STATE SENATOR GAIL DAVENPORT TO HOST A SENIOR CITIZENS DINNER FOR CLAYTON COUNTY CITIZENS AT THE J. CHARLEY GRISWELL SENIOR CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Senior Services Department received a Special Facility Use Request from State Senator Gail Davenport (the "Host") for use of the J. Charley Griswell Senior Center (the "Location") to host a Senior Citizens Dinner for the purpose of allowing seniors in the community to come together to have dinner and meeting with Senator Davenport on October 19, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Host wishes to utilize the Location for the event from 2:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing the Host to facilitate this event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of the Clayton County Senior Services Department, to grant Senator Gail Davenport a Special Facility Use Request to host a Senior Citizens Dinner at the J. Charley Griswell

Senior Center on October 19, 2019, from 2:30 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. The Board authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




