RESOLUTION NO. 2019-162

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH VETTRAN; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, VetTran is a non-for-profit service working with the Veterans Administration and WellStar system to provide discounted transportation with their fleet of ambulances and sedans; and

WHEREAS, VetTran also partners with local public safety departments to assist veterans by providing free transportation to medical appointments; and

WHEREAS, VetTran has offered to service the veterans residing in Clayton County, without transportation, by providing one-way transportation to medical appointments one day a week; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the citizens of the County to enter into this agreement with VetTran and the Board desires to enter into an agreement with VetTran to support the transport of veterans for medical treatment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to enter into an agreement with VetTran to transport veterans that reside in Clayton County to medical appointments. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to

execute any agreement, subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as recommended by the County Attorney and as the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve, and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


