RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 34

A resolution to initiate changes to the zoning map accordingly; to provide an effective date of this resolution; and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners has the authority under O.C.G.A. § 36-66-4 to amend its Zoning Ordinance codified in Section 1.1 of Appendix A of the Clayton County Code; and

WHEREAS, the County also has the authority under O.C.G.A. § 36-66-4 to amend its Zoning Map codified in Section 5.1 of Appendix A of the Clayton County Code; and

WHEREAS, the County finds that is in the best interest of the citizens of Clayton County that these changes along with any modifications to the County's development standards are set forth with specificity to reduce or eliminate any adverse impact of these changes on the surrounding properties; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1.14(A)(1), the Board of Commissioners deem it in the best interest of the citizens of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by initiating a map amendment to the properties identified in District 4 as set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and adopting a new zoning map to reflect such changes.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF


Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


