RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 39

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH GEORGIA STATE UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE PARAMEDIC SKILLS INSTRUCTION FOR STUDENTS AND EMPLOYEES WITHIN CLAYTON COUNTY'S FIRE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE MOU AS REQUIRED UNDER THE TERMS OF THE MOU; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF THE MOU; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Fire and Emergency Services ("CCFES") employees currently enrolled in the paramedic program can receive credit hours towards a four-year degree at Georgia State University ("GSU"); and

WHEREAS, GSU has instructors capable of providing healthcare-related training for students of GSU, as well as, students/employees of CCFES; and

WHEREAS, GSU has offered to provide bi-directional opportunities for students of GSU, as well as, students/employees of CCFES to gain additional educational opportunities through shared resources by creating a paramedic pathway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by providing students/employees of

CCFES with the opportunity to expand pathway participation and receive college credit;
and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believes that it is in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will be best served by entering into a memorandum of understanding with GSU to provide paramedic instruction for students/employees within Clayton County's Fire and Emergency Services department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Georgia State University to provide paramedic training for students/employees within Clayton County's Fire and Emergency Services department. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




