RESOLUTION NO. 2020 – 42

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT GRANT FUNDS FROM THE AMERICAN LIBRARY ASSOCIATION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY AGREEMENT AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE RELATING THERETO; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, there is evidence that trade jobs are going unfulfilled due to retiring trade workers and, by the year 2028, there will be an estimated 3 million trade jobs available; and

WHEREAS, the American Library Association offers a grant through their Libraries Transform Grant that is intended to help libraries expand and deepen their community engagement efforts and will help improve the quality of life for our citizens by helping them develop viable job skills; and

WHEREAS these funds will help the County prepare for training and access for citizens, students and other persons interested in becoming part of the trades field; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to apply and accept grant funding from the American Library Association through their Libraries Transform Grant allocated specifically for training in jobs such as heating, vacuum and air conditioning, solar repair, plumbing, electrical and facility maintenance to improve the health and welfare of its citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to apply for and accept a grant funds from the American Library Association through their Libraries Transform Grant allocated specifically for training in jobs such as heating, vacuum and air conditioning, solar repair, plumbing, electrical and facility maintenance. The Board authorizes the Chairman to execute any Agreement and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense relating thereto.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
