

IMPORTANT SURNAME INFORMATION

The name you enter as your current “full name” must be your name as it appears on your Birth Certificate, Driver’s License, Passport, Military Identification, Permanent Resident Card, Resident Alien Card, Certificate of Naturalization, or any other document you present to the Court as proof of your identity. This is the name that will appear on your Marriage License. If this name is spelled incorrectly, is out of order, or is otherwise wrong, you may encounter problems with state or federal agencies such as Social Security or Immigration and Naturalization Services.

The name you enter as your “designated surname” will be your legal name after you are married. If you intend to change your last name after you get married but fail to put the correct designated surname on your Marriage License Application, you may encounter problems changing your name after marriage with state or federal agencies, such as the Department of Driver Services, Social Security, or with your financial institution(s). This Court WILL NOT amend your Application to change your designated surname after you are married.
