RE: Clayton County Solicitor-General's Office Accessibility Notice

In accord with the orders of The Honorable Justice Harold Melton, Chief Justice of the Georgia Supreme Court and The Honorable Geronda Carter, Chief Judge of the Clayton Judicial Circuit, issued on March 14, 2020, amended on May 11, 2020 and March 13, 2020, amended on May 13, 2020 respectively. The Office of the Solicitor-General of the State Court of Clayton County will be open to limited public access beginning March 16, 2020 thru the duration of the Declaration of Statewide Judicial Emergency. During this period, office personnel will be at the office on a limited schedule to address essential court proceedings, public safety and citizen needs.

The office business hours are Monday thru Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The main office telephone number is 770.477.3380 and will be answered during normal business hours. Should you reach the office after business hours, if you leave a detailed message we will be sure to return your call as soon as possible in the order of priority from essential/critical court matters to non-essential/critical matters.


