RESOLUTION NO. 2020 – 110

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO AMEND ITS PY2020 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN TO THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (“HUD”) TO ACCEPT FUNDING UNDER THE SECOND WAVE OF THE CORONAVIRUS AID, RELIEF, AND ECONOMIC SECURITY ACT (CARES ACT); TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, in an effort to mitigate the effects of COVID-19, the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has awarded to entitlement communities additional Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) and the Emergency Solution Grant (ESG-CV) funds; and

WHEREAS, as part of its allocation of these additional funds, HUD requires grantees to submit an amendment to its current 2020 Annual Action Plan which details the proposed use of HUD funding and prescribes the activities that the grantee is taking to address the adverse effects in the communities of the COVID-19 pandemic as well as meet the strategies, goals, and objectives contained in the five-year Consolidated Plan; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County desires to submit an amendment to its 2020 Annual Action Plan to HUD to accept funding under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act which was enacted on March 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the County will receive \$1,674,553 in Emergency Solution Grant funds to be awarded by the County to individuals and families who are homeless or receiving homeless assistance and to support additional homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will be best served by amending its PY2020 HUD Annual Action Plan for the stated purposes.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the submission of an amendment to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development of the County's PY2020 HUD Annual Action Plans to accept funding under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) to be awarded by the County to individuals and families who are homeless to mitigate the impacts of COVID-19. The Board also authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, as may be required.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


