RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 132

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO RENEW THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR MUTUAL AID WITH ATLANTA TECHNICAL COLLEGE EXTENSION CAMPUS PROVIDING FOR RECIPROCAL RESPONSE TO EMERGENCIES WITHIN EACH RESPECTIVE JURISDICTION SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF RESOURCES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN AND THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the laws of Georgia authorize local governments and institutions of the Technical College System of Georgia to provide mutual aid; and

WHEREAS, the parties currently have an Agreement to provide mutual aid in emergencies subject to the availability of resources and the current Agreement is set to end on June 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by renewing the Agreement for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED




all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution.






