RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 153

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CONSOLIDATION OF COUNTY CODE ENFORCEMENT UNDER THE CLAYTON COUNTY CORRECTIONS DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE A SUPPLEMENT TO THE WARDEN'S SALARY AS CONSIDERATION FOR THESE ADDITIONAL MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE RELATING THERETO; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County, Georgia (the "County") is a political subdivision duly organized and existing under the Constitution and the laws of the State of Georgia; and

WHEREAS, currently the County officers and staff responsible for County Code Enforcement are assigned under two separate County Departments, the Clayton County Police Department and the Clayton County Community Development Department; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Clayton County Board of Commissioners' ("the Board") quality of life initiatives, County staff convened to devise and recommend a plan to consolidate the County's Code Enforcement functions to maximize efficiency and structure to code enforcement in the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed and desires to adopt the Code Enforcement Consolidation Project ("the Consolidation Plan") drafted by Clayton County

Corrections Warden Dennis Nelson (“the Warden”), a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment “A”; and

WHEREAS, given the extra duties that this Consolidation Plan will place on the Corrections Department, the Board finds that it is appropriate to authorize a supplement to the salary of the Warden as head of that department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by adopting the proposed Consolidation Plan for consolidation of the Code Enforcement officers and functions under and into the County Corrections Department for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the implementation of the Code Enforcement Consolidation Project attached hereto as Attachment “A” for the consolidation of Code Enforcement functions and personnel to be reassigned and managed by the Corrections Department under the supervision of the Warden. To account for the performance of these additional management responsibilities, the Board authorizes a 10% supplement to the Warden’s salary for as long as Code Enforcement duties are assigned to the Corrections Department. The Board further authorizes the Chairman to perform all other acts necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution. The Board also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense relating thereto.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




