RESOLUTION NO. 2020-158

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A DONATION FROM JEN-CARE ON BEHALF OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY SENIOR SERVICES DEPARTMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Jen-Care wishes to donate a 2018 eight passenger van to the Clayton County Senior Services department; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Senior Services department plans to assign the van to the Northeast Senior Center; and

WHEREAS, the County will have to cover the cost of purchasing a tag, re-wrapping the van, and any cost associated with the preventative maintenance of the van; and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by accepting the van donation for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED






Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
