RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 161

A RESOLUTION OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING THE USE OF VARIOUS FACILITIES FOR ADVANCE VOTING WITH EXTENDED OPERATING DAYS AND HOURS FOR THE GENERAL PRIMARY RUNOFF SPECIAL ELECTION IN CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICT 5; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Elections and Registration has recommended that the County authorize usage of County facilities to conduct advance voting with extended operating days and hours for the Special Election in Congressional District 5 to be held on September 29, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Elections and Registration has recommended that the Historic Courthouse Ceremonial Courtroom, Virginia Burton Gray Recreation Center, and Carl Rhodenizer Recreation Center be open to allow electors to participate in advance voting to be held on several dates between September 8, 2020 and September 25, 2020 for the Special Election; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners has determined that advance voting at the times, dates and locations as recommended by the Board of Elections and Registration is in the best interest of all parties in Clayton County to reduce long lines on election day and to facilitate increased participation in the election process.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF

CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes advance voting and extended times for the September 29, 2020, Special Election to be held at the Historic Courthouse Ceremonial Courtroom, Virginia Burton Gray Recreation Center, and Carl Rhodenizer Recreation Center on the following dates:

Monday – Friday, September 8, 2020 - September 25, 2020


Section 2. The Board authorizes the Chairman to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.


Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective upon the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


