RESOLUTION NO. 2020 - 162

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH YOUTH SERVICE AMERICA TO COMPLETE THE SERVICEVOTE 2020 FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, research shows that communities of color, young people, and low-income citizens are disproportionately burdened by registration barriers, making it more difficult for these groups to vote. Participation gaps persist along race, income, and age-level; and

WHEREAS, Youth Service America (“YSA”) collaborates with Partner Organizations to engage youth as active citizens in the political process to increase voter participation through the award of ServiceVote 2020 Fellowships. Partner Organizations support selected ServiceVote 2020 Fellows by leveraging existing partnerships and connecting key stakeholders in the local area to mobilize voters; and

WHEREAS, YSA awarded a ServiceVote 2020 Fellowship to Clayton County as a Partner Organization in the amount of \$500 with no matching funds. The Fellowship also requires Clayton County to collaborate with a YSA selected Fellow in the ServiceVote 2020 program to disburse an additional \$500 in mini-grant funds to local projects; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will be best served by entering into a Memorandum of Understanding with YSA for the above stated purpose.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with Youth Service America to support the ServiceVote 2020 Fellow, leverage existing partnerships, and connect with and convene key stakeholders in the area for the purpose of voter mobilization efforts. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners or his designee to execute any documents and perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective upon the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


