RESOLUTION NO. 2020-174

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CLAYTON COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY CONCERNING VEHICLE MAINTENANCE AND FUEL; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS RELATING THERETO AND TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, the Clayton County Housing Authority (“CCHA”) wishes to enter into a vehicle maintenance agreement with the Clayton County Transportation and Development department; and

**WHEREAS**, CCHA currently has one vehicle they would like the County to service and provide fuel.; and

**WHEREAS**, the County services vehicles for the Community Services Authority (“CSA”), charging them material costs plus an hourly labor rate.

**WHEREAS**, the County also provides fuel for the City of Jonesboro, charging them actual fuel costs.; and

**WHEREAS**, the addition of one vehicle will not affect the County’s level of service; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by entering in an agreement with the Clayton County Housing Authority for the stated purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of Clayton County Transportation and Development department, to enter into a vehicle maintenance and fuel agreement with the Clayton County Housing Authority. The Board also authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
