

## What's going on?

The Clayton County Department of Transportation and Development is updating its Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP). The CTP Update will serve as a framework for how Clayton County will improve its transportation networks to serve current and future needs.

The plan considers the complete transportation network in Clayton County: roadways and bridges, bicycle and pedestrian facilities, freight facilities and movement, and access to transit. It also considers impacts from the world's busiest airport, Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

## What will it include?

As shown in the illustration below, the CTP Update will engage the public continually and;

1. **Inventory** existing transportation conditions in Clayton County
2. **Assess** existing and future transportation needs
3. **Recommend** projects to address identified needs
4. **Prioritize** projects using study goals, needs and public input
5. Draft short-, medium-, and long-term **project programs** based on available and potential funding

*Our goal is for the Clayton County 2017 CTP Update to be sound and implementable, include recommendations that will yield economic, environmental and quality of life benefits to the County, and reflect input from all users of the Clayton County transportation network.*
