RESOLUTION NO. 2015-26

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO CONTINUE ITS PARTICIPATION IN THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION'S ORGANIZED CRIMES DRUG ENFORCEMENT TASK FORCE KNOWN AS THE DAVID G. WILHELM STRIKE FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (M.O.U.); TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED IN TERMS OF THE M.O.U.; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department participates in the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Organized Crimes Drug Enforcement Task Force Known as the David G. Wilhelm Strike Force with participation from various federal, state, and local area law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners previously approved the County's participation in the Task Force in Resolution 2011-160; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by participation in the David G. Wilhelm Strike Force.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to continue its participation in the Federal Bureau of Investigation's (F.B.I.) Organized Crimes Drug Enforcement Task Force Known as the David G. Wilhelm Strike Force. The Board of Commissioners the Chief of Police to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the F.B.I. The Board of Commissioners

also authorizes the Chairman to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the M.O.U.

Section 2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its approval by the Clayton County Board of Commissioners.




