RESOLUTION NO. 2014-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (M.O.U.) WITH THE UNITED STATES FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE METRO ATLANTA CHILD EXPLOITATION TASK FORCE TO FOCUS ON SEXUAL VICTIMIZATION AND OTHER CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN OCCURRING IN METRO ATLANTA INCLUDING CLAYTON COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN OR THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE M.O.U. AND OVERTIME AUTHORIZATION AGREEMENT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED IN THE TERMS OF THE M.O.U. AND THE AGREEMENT; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) has created the Metro Atlanta Child Exploitation Task Force to target sexual exploitation of children and other crimes against children with participation from various area law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department has been invited to participate in this program; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by participation in the task Force.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the, Chairman of the Board of Commissioners, or the Chief of Police as the Chairman's designee, to execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Federal Bureau of Investigations (FBI) to participate in the Metro Atlanta Child Exploitation Task Force.

The FBI will reimburse the County for overtime payments subject to the availability of funds. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman, or the Chief of Police as his designee to execute the Overtime Authorization Agreement. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


