RESOLUTION NO. 2007 - 08

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2005-103 WHICH PROVIDED THAT THE ELIMINATION OR REORGANIZATION OF COUNTY DEPARTMENTS REQUIRED THE UNANIMOUS APPROVAL OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is responsible for, among other things, setting the policies of the County and otherwise voting on matters pertaining to the affairs of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by reviewing and approving by Resolution the elimination or reorganization of County departments as they exist; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2005-103 required that unanimous approval of the Board of Commissioners was needed in order to eliminate or reorganize a county department; and

WHEREAS, the legality of Resolution 2005-103 was raised at the time it was enacted and since the resolution the Board in 2006 voted to reorganize the Department of Risk Management and Safety, which vote was not unanimous; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believes it is in the best interest of the County to rescind Resolution 2005-103.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED




Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




