ORDINANCE NO. 2016 - 164

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY PART I, CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE IV “PURCHASES AND PROPERTY DISPOSITION”, DIVISION 2 “PURCHASING AGENT”, SECTION 2-107 “BOND” SO AS TO DELETE SECTION 2-107 IN ITS ENTIRETY AND REPLACE IT WITH A NEW SECTION 2-107 ENTITLED “BOND”; TO AMEND PART I, CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE IV “PURCHASES AND PROPERTY DISPOSITION”, DIVISION 2 “PURCHASING AGENT”, SO AS TO ADD SECTION 2-109.1 ENTITLED “DEPUTY PURCHASING AGENT”; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

**Section 1.** The *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part I, Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article IV “Purchases and Property Disposition”, Section 2-107 “Bond” by deleting Section 2-107 in its entirety and replace with a new Section 2-107 entitled “Bond” to read as follows:

“The purchasing agent shall for himself/herself and his/her subordinate personnel give a blanket bond in the sum of \$25,000.00, payable to the ordinary, conditioned on the faithful accounting by the purchasing agent and his/her subordinate personnel to the county for all goods and money that may come into their hands in their official capacities, and to indemnify and save the county harmless for and on account of all their acts in said positions. The bond shall be furnished by the purchasing agent before entering upon the discharge of his/her duties

and shall be maintained by the purchasing agent during his/her entire term of office. The premium for the bond required by this section shall be paid from county funds.”

**Section 2.** The *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding Part I, Chapter 2 “Administration”, Article IV “Purchases and Property Disposition”, Section 2-106.1 entitled “Deputy Purchasing Agent” to read as follows:

“There is hereby created the office of deputy purchasing agent. The deputy purchasing agent shall be the assistant director of the purchasing department. The term of office of the deputy purchasing agent shall be concurrent with the term as assistant director of the purchasing department. The deputy purchasing agent shall assume the duties of the purchasing agent in his/her absence.”

**Section 3.** All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall become effective on immediately upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


