RESOLUTION NO. 2016 - 186

A RESOLUTION TO REPEAL RESOLUTION 96-95 WHICH ESTABLISHED THE LEVEL OF SUPPLEMENTAL COMPENSATION FOR THE JUDGES OF THE STATE COURT OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND APPROVED THE LEVEL OF COMPENSATION FOR JUDGES OF THE JUVENILE COURT OF CLAYTON COUNTY; TO CONTINUE IN EFFECT THAT THE JUDGES OF THE STATE COURT OF CLAYTON COUNTY ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE IN THE CLAYTON COUNTY PUBLIC EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT SYSTEM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on August 20, 1996, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners approved Resolution 96-95, which established the level of supplemental compensation for judges of the State Court of Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 96-95 also approved the level of compensation for judges of the Juvenile Court of Clayton County consistent with the total level of compensation for judges of the State Court of Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 96-95 discontinued the participation of judges of the State Court in the Clayton County Public Employee Retirement System ("Pension Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Commissioners wishes to repeal Resolution 96-95 and continue in effect that the judges of the State Court of Clayton County

are no eligible to participate in the Clayton County Public Employee Retirement System (“Pension Plan”).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby repeals Resolution 96-95, Sections 1 thru 3, such that the Clayton County Board of Commissioners will no longer provide supplemental compensation for judges of the State Court of Clayton County.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners herby repeals Resolution 96-95, Section 4, such that the level of compensation for judges of the Juvenile Court of Clayton County will no longer be based on the supplemental compensation for judges of the State Court of Clayton County, but will be provided pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-11-54, which states that the judges of the Juvenile Court of Clayton County shall be compensated consistent with other County employees but shall not be eligible for retirement or pension benefits.

Section 3. The Board of Commissioners hereby continues in effect that the judges of the State Court of Clayton County shall not be eligible for participation in the Clayton County Public Employee Retirement System (“Pension Plan”).

Section 4. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, as may be required to accomplish the intent of the resolution.

Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


