RESOLUTION NO. 2015-108

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A CONDEMNED VEHICLE TO BE ASSIGNED TO THE CLAYTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FLEET IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Sheriff's Office seized a 2007 Chevrolet Tahoe, (VIN) 1GNFC13097R240714 during a joint drug investigation with the U.S. Marshall Service; and

WHEREAS, Fleet Maintenance has determined said vehicle is excellent condition and has recommended the unit for service as a County vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle will be used by VICE and Fugitive investigators;

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicle sought to be condemned can be effectively used for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by placing said vehicle in the Sheriff's Office Fleet in accordance with applicable County Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

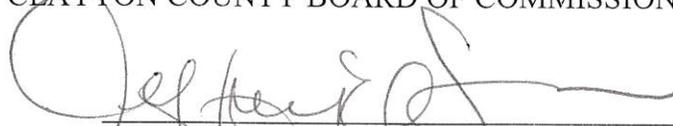
Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept title to a 2007 Chevrolet Tahoe, VIN 1GNFC13097R240714 seized during a joint

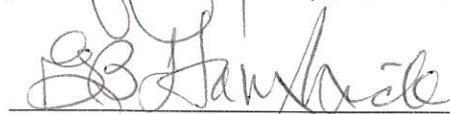
drug investigation with U.S. Marshalls Service and to assign said vehicle to the Clayton County Sheriff's Office vehicle fleet for the purpose of enhancing law enforcement. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Director of Central Service, Fleet Maintenance, and Chief Financial Officer to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

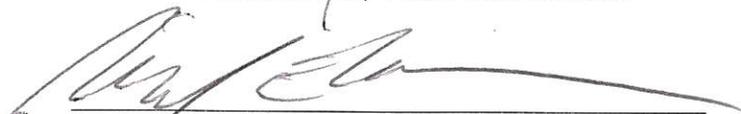
Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.

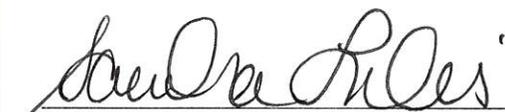
