RESOLUTION NO. 2015-122

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 2015-97, WHICH ALLOWED THE OAK FOREST NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH (SECTOR 4) TO HOST ITS 5TH ANNIVERSARY PICNIC AT CLAYTON COUNTY INTERNATIONAL PARK; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN AND THE DIRECTOR OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 2015-97, the Board of Commissioners authorized representatives of the Oak Forest Neighborhood Watch (Sector 4) (the "Host") to utilize the St. Vincent Pavilion at Clayton County International Park (the "Location") to host their 5th Anniversary Picnic to fellowship and discuss neighborhood crime and prevention; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved the Parks and Recreation Department's facility use cost of \$300.00 for rental of the St. Vincent Pavilion; and

WHEREAS, the Host now requests reconsideration by the Board of Commissioners to allow complimentary use of the St. Vincent Pavilion on May 16, 2015 from 10:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M. for the event; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing the Host to facilitate this event as contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED



Section 2. This Resolution shall be immediately effective upon approval by the Board of Commissioners.




