RESOLUTION NO. 2015-127

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO A LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH JOHN SAMUEL GOSART TO SPONSOR AND HOST A 5K RUN AT CLAYTON COUNTY INTERNATIONAL PARK TO RAISE FUNDS FOR THE ARMOR OF GOD PROJECT; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on behalf of MacKenna Gosart and “Run for the Blue”, John Samuel Gosart (the “Promoter”) submitted a Special Facility Use Request to the Parks and Recreation Department to sponsor and host a 5K run on September 19, 2015 from 8:00 A.M. to 12:00 P.M. at Clayton County International Park, to include recorded music, to raise funds for the Armor of God Project (the “Event”); and

WHEREAS, all funds raised during the Event will be donated to the Armor of God Project, which provides ballistic vests to law enforcement officers whose departments cannot afford to purchase them; and

WHEREAS, the Promoter has sole responsibility for organizing, promoting and managing the Event, with no capital expense to Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Parks and Recreation Department (the “Department”) is requesting consideration by the Board of Commissioners to approve the Department’s recommended event rental fee for the Event; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by authorizing the Promoter to host the Event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners authorizes Clayton County to enter into a License Agreement with John Samuel Gosart (the “Promoter”) to sponsor and host a 5K run at Clayton County International Park on September 19, 2015, to include recorded music, to raise funds to benefit the Armor of God Project. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute the License Agreement attached hereto as Attachment “A”, subject to any deletions and revisions that the Board of Commissioners may approve, and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners approves the Parks and Recreation Department’s recommended fee as outlined in the License Agreement, to be paid by the Promoter for the Event.






