RESOLUTION NO. 2015-141

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT, HOMELAND SECURITY INVESTIGATIONS AGENCY FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF COUNTY OVERTIME AND OTHER EXPENSES FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE JOINT OPERATIONS TASK FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT, AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department participates in the Joint Operations Task Force with Immigration and Customs Enforcement, Homeland Security Investigations Agency (ICE); and

WHEREAS, ICE is authorized is reimburse overtime and other related expenses from the United States Treasury Forfeiture Fund, with electronic deposit; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will be best served by participating in this agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute an agreement with the Immigration and Customs Enforcement Homeland Security Investigations Special Agent in Charge for the purpose of reimbursing the County for

overtime and other expenses associated with the County's participation in the Joint Operations Task Force and otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the agreement and to authorize electronic payment from the United States Government to the County treasury.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.






