RESOLUTION NO. 2015 – 275

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING COMMISSIONER GAIL B. HAMBRICK TO PARTNER WITH FASTPARK & RELAX TO HOST A JOB FAIR AT THE VIRGINIA B. GRAY RECREATION CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET AS NEEDED TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, FastPark & Relax (the “Partner”), in partnership with Commissioner Gail B. Hambrick, wishes to host a Job Fair (the “Event”); and

WHEREAS, the Event will be held at the Virginia B. Gray Recreation Center and the event will commence on Tuesday, November 17, 2015 until Thursday, November 19, 2015. The event will be held each day from 9:00am until 2:00pm and again from 5:00pm until 8:00pm; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County by authorizing Commissioner Gail B. Hambrick and the Partner to host the Event; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Commissioner Gail B. Hambrick to partner with FastPark & Relax to host a Job Fair at the Virginia B. Gray Recreation Center. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of the Resolution. The Board further authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget as needed to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense all as may be required under the terms of the agreement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


