ORDINANCE NO. 2015-288

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY PART II, CHAPTER 42 “FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION”, ARTICLE II “FIRE PREVENTION CODE”, SECTION 42-40 “FEES” SO AS TO DELETE SECTION 42-40 IN ITS ENTIRETY AND REPLACE WITH A NEW SECTION 42-40 TO BE ENTITLED “FEES”, TO INCLUDE LANGUAGE REFLECTING CHANGES IN GEORGIA STATE LAW; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS TO PROVIDE SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The *CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA*, as amended, is hereby further amended by amending Part II, Chapter 42 “Fire Prevention And Protection”, Article II “Fire Prevention Code”, Section 42-40 “Fees” so as to delete Section 42-40 in its entirety and replace with a new Section 42-40 to be entitled “Fees” to include language outlining changes in Georgia state law, which shall read as follows:

“Sec. 42-40. - Fees.

The following fees and charges are hereby adopted for the county fire department:

- (1) New anhydrous ammonia permit for storage in bulk (more than 2,000 gallons aggregate capacity) for sale or distribution one-time fee.....\$150.00
- (2) Annual license for manufacture of explosives other than fireworks.....\$150.00
- (3) 30 day license for temporary fireworks sales.....\$500.00 per location

- (4) Certificate of occupancy.....\$100.00
- (5) Construction plan review:
  - a. Bulk storage construction.....\$150.00
  - b. Building construction per square foot.....0.15
  - c. Fire sprinkler contractor certificate of competency.....\$150.00
  - d. Liquefied petroleum gas storage permit:
    - 1. 2,000 gallons or less.....\$150.00
    - 2. More than 2,000 gallons.....\$600.00
  - e. Building construction inspection:
    - 1. Site inspection, 80 percent completion, 100 percent completion and first follow-up inspections.....None
    - 2. Second follow up inspection.....\$150.00
    - 3. Third and subsequent follow-up inspections.....\$220.00
  - f. Purchase, storage, sale transport or use of explosives other than fireworks:
    - 1. 500 lbs. or less.....\$75.00
    - 2. More than 500 lbs. ....\$150.00
- (6) Existing building fire safety inspection fee.....\$100.00
- (7) New permit to dispense compressed natural gas (CNG) for vehicular fuel onetime fee.....\$150.00.”

Section 2. All laws, ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. If any part of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect the remainder of this enactment, and such remainder shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


