RESOLUTION NO. 2015-304

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISPOSITION OF AN UNSERVICEABLE 1994 FORD F450 AIR & LIGHT FIRE TRUCK, VIN# 1FDLF47M1REA37095 FROM THE CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, PREVIOUSLY USED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, TO BE DONATED TO THE CITY OF JONESBORO, GEORGIA, POLICE DEPARTMENT; TO ACCEPT DONATION OF A POLE CAMERA FROM THE CITY OF JONESBORO, GEORGIA; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS NECESSARY; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE DISPOSITION OF THE 1994 FORD 450 AIR & LIGHT TRUCK; VIN# 1FDLF47M1REA37095; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County has a 1994 Ford 450 Air & Light Truck, VIN# 1FDLF47M1REA37095 and wishes to donate it to the City of Jonesboro, Georgia, in exchange for a pole camera of comparable value to the County; and

WHEREAS, the 1994 Ford 450 Air & Light Truck, VIN# 1FDLF47M1REA37095 is not acceptable to be put in service as a County fire and emergency vehicle and it is advisable to dispose of the vehicle (“unserviceable vehicle”); and

WHEREAS; it is hereby determined that the vehicle sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used to benefit the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by this vehicle; and

WHEREAS; the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will be best served by disposing of the unserviceable vehicle by donating it to the City of Jonesboro, Georgia in exchange for a pole camera.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to dispose of an unserviceable 1994 Ford 450 Air & Light Truck, VIN# 1FDLF47M1REA37095 by donating it to the City of Jonesboro, Georgia, Police Department, in exchange for a pole camera from the City of Jonesboro. The exchange of donations will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances. The Chairman of the Board of Commissioners is authorized to execute all documents necessary and to perform all acts necessary to effect the resolution. The Director of Central Services and the Chief Financial Officer are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
