RESOLUTION NO. 2014-107

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT, ON BEHALF OF Clayton County, TO APPLY FOR JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT FUNDING TO SUPPORT THERAPEUTIC SERVICES FOR HIGH-RISK DESIGNATED FELONY OFFENDERS ASSIGNED TO THE SECOND CHANCE COURT PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE GRANT APPLICATION AND OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Juvenile Court, on behalf of the Clayton County, previously applied for Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (“JABG”) funding to provide cognitive behavior therapy, intensive family intervention services, substance abuse treatment and life skills training over a three year period; and

WHEREAS, Juvenile Court now wishes to apply for and, if awarded, accept the third and final year of funding; and

WHEREAS, if awarded, the grant funds will total \$74,920.00 with no County financial match required; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by authorizing Juvenile Court to apply for and, if awarded, accept the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant funding for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS


OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County Juvenile Court to apply for and, if awarded, accept Juvenile Accountability Block Grant funding in the amount of \$74,920.00. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the Grant Application as well as any related documents, and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
