RESOLUTION NO. 2014-205

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRADE, SALE OR OTHER DISPOSITION OF CLAYTON COUNTY OWNED SERVICE WEAPONS FROM THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE DISPOSITION OF SAID WEAPONS AS SURPLUS ITEMS; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DISBURSEMENT OF PROCEEDS FROM THE DISPOSITION OF SUCH PROPERTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County District Attorney's Office employees carry service weapons in the official performance of their duties; and

WHEREAS, a significant number of these service weapons are 16 years or older and at least one-third of the inventory is 23 years old; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the service weapons sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used for the benefit of the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by these weapons; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by authorizing the Director of Central Services to affect the trade, sale or other disposition of these weapons to Ed's Public Safety pursuant to the offers as evidenced in Exhibit A attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Board also authorizes the Director of Central Services to use the proceeds from the sale to acquire replacement service weapons for the District Attorney's Office.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Central Services to affect the trade, sale or other disposition of County owned service weapons used by the District Attorney's Office to Ed's Public Safety in a manner that will be in the best interest of the County and in accordance with Section 2-146 of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances. The proceeds from the sale of these weapons shall be used to purchase replacement service weapons for the District Attorney's Office. The Director of Central Services and the Chief Financial Officer are authorized to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
