RESOLUTION NO. 2014-275

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO ACCEPT A MOTOR VEHICLE FROM THE UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE TO BE USED BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE OFFICER ASSIGNED TO THE REGIONAL FUGITIVE TASK FORCE; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ANY ACT NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF FLEET MAINTENANCE TO ACCEPT THE MOTOR VEHICLE AND PLACE IT INTO THE COUNTY'S INVENTORY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners authorized the Clayton County Police Department to participate in the United States Marshall Service's Regional Fugitive Task Force in Resolution 2010-62; and

WHEREAS, the Marshals Service wishes to donate a motor vehicle to Clayton County to be used by the officer assigned to the Regional Fugitive Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by continuing to participate in this Regional Fugitive Task Force and accepting the donation of a motor vehicle from the United States Marshals Service.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept the donation of a motor vehicle from the United States Marshalls Service, to be used by the Clayton County police officer assigned to the Regional Fugitive Task Force. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Chairman to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense. The Board of Commissioners also authorizes the Director of Fleet Maintenance to place the donated vehicle in service and assign the vehicle to the Police Department for use consistent with the intent of this Resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
