RESOLUTION NO. 2014-300

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CLAYTON COUNTY EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN BY ADDING ANNEX I “CLAYTON COUNTY CONTINUITY OF GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS PLAN”; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, in 2001 the Board of Commissioners authorized the implementation of a comprehensive emergency operations plan to ensure the preparedness, mitigation, appropriate response and timely recovery from natural or man-made disasters or emergencies affecting Clayton County; and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that the changing threat environment and local experience with recent emergencies have emphasized the need to develop Continuity of Government (“COG”) capabilities that enable government leaders and departments to continue essential functions across a broad spectrum of emergencies; and

WHEREAS, the Board further recognizes that government operations can be disrupted by a variety of events, both manmade and natural; and

WHEREAS, amending the Clayton County Emergency Operations Plan (“EOP”) by adding “Annex I – Clayton County Continuity of Government Plan” will allow Clayton County to ensure that the essential governmental functions will continue in response to operational interruptions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by amending the EOP for the reasons contemplated herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby amends the Clayton County Emergency Operations Plan by adding "Annex I – Clayton County Continuity of Government Plan". The Board authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board also authorizes the Chief Financial Officer to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




