RESOLUTION NO. 2013 - 54

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF CONDEMNED VEHICLES TO BE ASSIGNED TO THE CLAYTON COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FLEET IN A MANNER AS WILL BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE COUNTY; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Sheriff's Office seized a 2002 Nissan Maxima, (VIN) JN1DA31A92T320459 and a 2007 Chevrolet Van, (VIN)1GCHG35U671146435 during criminal investigations; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Sheriff's Office did petition the District Attorney's Office for forfeiture of said vehicles to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton County has forfeited ownership and title of said vehicles to the County under Court order in case numbers 2012-CV-03028-9 and 2012-CV-00723-8; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Fleet Maintenance has determined said vehicles require only minor repairs and has recommended the units for service as County vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the use of unmarked vehicles are used extensively by the Sheriff's Office throughout its operation;

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicles sought to be condemned can be effectively used for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by placing said vehicles in the Sheriff's Office Fleet in accordance with applicable County Ordinances.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept title to a 2002 Nissan Maxima, VIN JN1DA31A92T320459 and a 2007 Chevrolet Van, VIN 1GCHG35U671146435 seized during criminal investigations and to assign said vehicles to the Clayton County Sheriff's Office vehicle fleet for the purpose of enhancing law enforcement in accordance with Clayton County Superior Court order case numbers 2012-CV-03028-9 and 2012-CV-00723-8. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Directors of Central Service, Fleet Maintenance, and Finance to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


