RESOLUTION NO. 2013 – 57

A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE A SPECIAL FACILITY USE REQUEST TO ALLOW STATE SENATOR GAIL DAVENPORT TO HOST A BLACK HISTORY MONTH CELEBRATION FOR CLAYTON COUNTY SENIOR ADULTS AT THE J. CHARLEY GRISWELL SENIOR CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, State Senator Gail Davenport (the “Host”) wishes to utilize the J. Charley Griswell Senior Center (the “Location”) to host a Black History Month Celebration for Clayton County Senior Adults on February 24, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Host wishes to utilize the Location for the event from 2:00 p.m. until 6:30 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, Clayton County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing the Host to facilitate this event.

OF CLAYTON COUNTY GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED






