ORDINANCE NO. 2013 – 150

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CLAYTON COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS, AS AMENDED, SPECIFICALLY TO DELETE RULE 7.202 “APPOINTMENT TYPES”, SUBPARAGRAPH (C) “TEMPORARY APPOINTMENTS” AND SUBPARAGRAPH (D) “PART-TIME APPOINTMENTS” AND TO INSERT IN LIEU THEREOF NEW LANGUAGE AS PROVIDED HEREIN; TO REPEAL ANY AND ALL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners adopted certain Civil Service Rules and Regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, with the approval of the Clayton County Civil Service Board, desires to amend said Rules and Regulations with regard to “Appointment Types”.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

**Section 1.** Clayton County Civil Service Rule 7.202(c) is hereby deleted in its entirety and inserted in lieu thereof language to read as follows:

**7.202 (c) Temporary Appointments** - A temporary appointment is the filling of a position which entails work of a non-recurring nature and of limited duration. Temporary appointment shall be made from registers of eligible applicants for the class of position, and in accordance with all appointment provisions of these Rules and Regulations. They shall be for a period not to exceed six (6) months. Temporary appointees shall acquire no Civil Service status or benefits. Temporary appointees shall not be reappointed to another temporary or part time position for a period of 26 weeks following the completion of a temporary assignment. Temporary employment shall not affect a person’s standing on existing eligible registers, nor shall it prejudice the employee’s chances of receiving a regular appointment.

**Section 2.** Clayton County Civil Service Rule 7.202(d) is hereby deleted in its entirety and inserted in lieu thereof language to read as follows:

**7.202 (d) Part-Time Appointments** - A part-time appointment is the filling of a position which requires the continuing services of an employee for twenty five (25) hours or less per week. Recruitment, testing, certification, and selections shall be in the same manner as for regular

appointments. Employees in this category shall be governed by the provisions of these Rules and Regulations as are other classified employees, but shall acquire no Civil Service status or benefits.


**Section 3.** All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations, or parts thereof which conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** It is declared to be the intention of the Board of Commissioners that all sections and paragraphs of this Ordinance are or were, upon their enactment, believed to be fully valid, enforceable and constitutional. To the greatest extent allowed by law, each and every paragraph herein is severable from the other. In the event that any portion of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable by valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, it is the express intent of the Board of Commissioners that the remaining portions of the Ordinance shall remain valid, constitutional, enforceable, and of full force and effect.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 2013.


