ORDINANCE NO. 2013 – 158

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AS AMENDED; SPECIFICALLY PART II, CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE III “BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND AUTHORITIES”, DIVISION 4 “SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY”, SECTION 2-85 “SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY; CREATION; MEMBERSHIP; POWERS”; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING LAWS, ORDINANCES, AND RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County to amend the Code of Clayton County as hereinafter set forth.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby amends the Code of Clayton County, Georgia, as amended, specifically Part II, Chapter 2, “Administration”, Article III, “Boards, Commissions and Authorities”, Division 4 “Solid Waste Management Authority” Section 2-85(b), “Solid Waste Management Authority; Creation; Membership; Powers” by deleting the first paragraph of Subparagraph (b) and inserting in lieu thereof the following and by adding Subsection (b)(6) adding the Mayor of the City of Lovejoy and (b)(7) adding another Member appointed by the Board of Commissioners as members of the Board of Directors of the Clayton County Solid Waste Management Authority.

Sec. 2-85. - Solid waste management authority; creation; membership; powers.

(b) There are hereby appointed as members of the first Board of Directors of the Clayton County Solid Waste Management Authority (the "authority") the following named seven persons, each of whom is a taxpayer of the county residing in the county.

(6) Mayor of the City of Lovejoy

(7) Member appointed by Board of Commissioners


Section 2. In the event any section, paragraph, subpart, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of the Ordinance shall be declared or adjudged unconstitutional or invalid by any Court, such declaration or adjudication shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect as if the portions declared invalid or unconstitutional had never been enacted into law.

Section 3. All laws, ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
