WHEREAS, on June 27, 2013, the Board of Commissioners approved Budget Amendment #2-71 which provided funds and authorized the payment of a one time supplement to the Clayton County District Attorney pursuant to O.C.G.A. §15-18-1 et seq; and

WHEREAS, the Board now requests an official opinion from the Georgia Attorney General's Office regarding the legality of the Budget Amendment.




