RESOLUTION NO. 2013-248

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT TO IMPLEMENT A "VOLUNTEERS IN POLICE SERVICES" PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO DEVELOP GUIDELINES FOR THE PROGRAM AND SPECIFIC DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE VOLUNTEERS; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2013-24 authorized Clayton County to accept a Home Land Security grant to expand community volunteer organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Department has developed a volunteer program to support police services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by authorizing the creation of the Volunteers In Police Service program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the creation of a Volunteers In Police Services (VIPS) program. The Board further authorizes the Chief of Police or designee to develop Guidelines for the program and specific duties and responsibilities for the volunteers. Volunteers are to execute a waiver of liability, approved by the County Attorney, prior to the start of their volunteer service.

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners commends the citizen members of the VIPS program for their efforts to make our county safer for all. The commitment and dedication of these citizens is an inspiration for us all.

Section 3. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




