ORDINANCE NO. 2013-290

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED UNDER THE HOME RULE POWERS GRANTED TO CLAYTON COUNTY PURSUANT TO ARTICLE IX, SECTION II, PARAGRAPH I OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA OF 1983, AMENDING THE CLAYTON COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND SPECIFICALLY RELEVANT SECTIONS OF THE CLAYTON COUNTY CIVIL SERVICE ACT AND THE CIVIL SERVICES RULES AND REGULATIONS PERTAINING THERETO; TO PROVIDE FOR THE CREATION OF THE UNCLASSIFIED POSITION OF KINSHIP CARE LEADER; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County, Georgia, maintains the Clayton County Civil Service System (the "System") by an Act of the General Assembly of the State of Georgia, which was originally established and approved on April 2, 1963, and has been amended by Ga. L. 1994, p. 4399, and approved and signed by the Governor on March 29, 1994, and by ordinances adopted by the governing body of Clayton County, Georgia pursuant to their Home Rule powers; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners now desires to amend the Clayton County Civil Service Act, and the Civil Service Rules and Regulations pertaining thereto, to provide for the position of **Kinship Care Leader** as an unclassified position within the Clayton County government.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONER OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED

Section 1. By the authority granted to Clayton County pursuant to Article IX, Section II, Paragraph I of the Constitution of the State of Georgia of 1983, the Board of

Commissioners hereby amends the Clayton County Civil Service Act, and the Civil Service Rules and Regulations pertaining thereto, effective as of December 3, 2013, in the following particulars:

By adding the following unclassified position to Section 2(c) of the Civil Service Act, which lists Clayton County employees who may not be placed under the Civil Service System:

“Kinship Care Leader”


Section 2. The unclassified position of Kinship Care Leader will serve at the pleasure of the Director of the Clayton County Department of Senior Services (the “Director”) and will perform administrative duties under the direction of the Director in carrying out directives of the Board and will report to the Kinship Care Program Coordinator.
