RESOLUTION NO. 2012 – 69

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CLAYTON COUNTY TO CONVEY A TEMPORARY DRIVEWAY EASEMENT TO THE CITY OF RIVERDALE THROUGH, OVER AND ACROSS COUNTY OWNED PROPERTY AS SET FORTH IN THE ATTACHED EXHIBITS, FOR SR85 PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE EASEMENT AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE NECESSARY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Riverdale (the “City”) is in the process of obtaining property to improve SR85 Pedestrian Facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City has requested a Temporary Driveway Easement through, over and across County owned property (Parcel I.D. No. 0009009) which will allow the City connect an existing driveway with the new roadway during and after project construction; and

WHEREAS, the Easement will be constructed at the City’s expense and will automatically expire upon completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by granting the Temporary Driveway Easement as stated above.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF
CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to convey a Temporary Driveway Easement to the City of Riverdale, as set forth in the attached exhibits, for the purpose of improving SR85 Pedestrian Facilities. The Board authorizes the Chairman to execute the Easement and otherwise to perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required under the terms of the Easement.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.




