RESOLUTION 2012 – 89

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, ON BEHALF OF CLAYTON COUNTY JUVENILE COURT, TO ENTER INTO A REVISED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH BIG BROTHERS BIG SISTERS OF METRO ATLANTA TO PROVIDE MENTORING SERVICES TO JUVENILES WHO BECOME INVOLVED WITH THE COURT AND ARE REFERRED TO ITS MENTORING PROGRAM; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE THE REVISED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, on March 6, 2012, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution 2012-43 allowing the County to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU”) with Big Brother Big Sisters of Metro Atlanta (“BBBSMA”) on behalf of the Clayton County Juvenile Court (“CCJC”), and

WHEREAS, BBBSMA had to change some provisions of the original MOU in order to be in compliance with new policies of their national organization and has subsequently voided the original MOU and provided a revised MOU; and

WHEREAS, the changes made to the MOU do not impact the agreement between CCJC and BBBSMA; and

WHEREAS, BBBSMA provides mentoring services for children facing adversity in an effort to change their lives for better; and

WHEREAS, CCJC endeavors to protect and restore the children of Clayton County as secure and law-abiding members of society and to strengthen families; and

WHEREAS, in a collaborative effort with BBBSMA to promote a safe and secure community by utilizing prevention and treatment services with families and other organizations to ensure the well-being of children, CCJC wishes to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with BBBSMA to provide one-to-one mentoring services to juveniles who are referred to BBBSMA by CCJC for prevention services; and

WHEREAS, if authorized to enter into this MOU, BBBSMA will assume all transportation, liability and costs associated with the participation of Juveniles referred to BBBSMA from CCJC; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County, and the County will best be served by enter into the revised Memorandum of Understanding for the above stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County, on behalf of Juvenile Court, to enter into a revised Memorandum of Understanding with Big Brothers Big Sisters of Metro Atlanta to provide mentoring services to Juveniles referred to its agency at no costs to CCJC. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Chairman to execute the revised Memorandum of Understanding and to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.


