RESOLUTION NO. 2012 – 92

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE INCREASE IN FEES FOR HOMEOWNER TRASH./DEBRIS PICK-UPS BY CLAYTON COUNTY REFUSE CONTROL; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY AND OTHERWISE TO PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THE RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE, ALL AS MAY BE REQUIRED; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Clayton County Refuse Control (the “County”) has been providing Clayton County residents with homeowner trash/debris pick for a minimal fee of \$15.00 since 1997; and

WHEREAS, the cost/benefit ratio has changed since the \$15.00 rate was initially set in 1997; and

WHEREAS, a rate increase to a minimum of \$20.00 will better compensate the County for its labor, transportation, and landfill disposal; and

WHEREAS, the County deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will be served by increasing the rate charged for homeowner trash/debris pick-ups.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED


Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to increase the rate charged for homeowner trash/debris pick-up to a minimum of \$20.00; to authorize the Chairman to execute all documents necessary and otherwise to perform all

other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of the Resolution; to authorize the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
