RESOLUTION NO. 2012 – 120

A RESOLUTION BY THE CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AUTHORIZING THE CLAYTON COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH TO ESTABLISH NEW FEES FOR ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Board of Health wishes to establish new fees as they relate to Environmental Services to be performed by the Clayton County Environmental Health Office; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by authorizing the establishment of new fees relating thereto.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Clayton County Board of Health to establish new fees related to Environmental Services. The Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman to execute any necessary documents, and to otherwise perform all acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution. Further, the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the Director of Finance to amend the Budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense, all as may be required. The new fee schedule shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as

Exhibit "A", subject to such minor changes, insertions or deletions as the Chairman of the Board of Commissioners may approve.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
