RESOLUTION 2012 – 143

A RESOLUTION TO RENAME “JUSTICE CENTER” ROAD TO “RICHARD JOSEPH DALY MEMORIAL BOULEVARD”; TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND DEVELOPMENT TO ERECT SIGNS ON THE SUBJECT STREET THAT REFLECT THE RENAMING; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO OTHERWISE PERFORM ALL OTHER ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE FINANCE DIRECTOR TO AMEND THE BUDGET WHERE NECESSARY TO REFLECT AN APPROPRIATE REVENUE SOURCE AND EXPENSE; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Deputy Richard Joseph Daly gave his life to protect the lives and property of Clayton County citizens during the performance of his duties as a Public Safety Officer; and

WHEREAS, in memory of Deputy Daly, Clayton County wishes to rename “Justice Center” Road (located behind the Harold R. Banke Justice Center) to “Richard Joseph Daly Memorial Boulevard”; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County and the County will best be served by renaming “Justice Center” Road to “Richard Joseph Daly Memorial Boulevard” for the stated purpose.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the renaming of “Justice Center” Road to “Richard Joseph Daly Memorial Boulevard” in memory of Deputy Richard Daly. The Board also authorizes the Department of Transportation and

Development to erect signs on the subject street that reflect the renaming. The Board further authorizes the Chairman to perform all other acts necessary to accomplish the intent of this Resolution and authorizes the Finance Director to amend the budget where necessary to reflect an appropriate revenue source and expense.

Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
