RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 183

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SALE OR OTHER DISPOSITION OF CONDEMNED OR SEIZED VEHICLE FROM THE CLAYTON COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT DRUG TASK FORCE TO BE SOLD AT AUCTION; TO AUTHORIZE THE DIRECTOR OF CENTRAL SERVICES TO EFFECT THE SALE OF SAID VEHICLE AS A SURPLUS ITEM; TO AUTHORIZE THE DISBURSEMENT OF PROCEEDS FROM THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Drug Task Force seized a 2006 Suzuki GSX, MC, VIN #JS1GN7DA562116331 during a drug investigation; and

WHEREAS, the Clayton County Police Drug Task Force did petition the District Attorney for forfeiture of said vehicle to the County; and

WHEREAS, the Superior Court of Clayton County has forfeited said vehicle to the County under court order in case number 2012-CV-0278-6; and

WHEREAS, the vehicle is not acceptable to be put in service as a County vehicle and it is advisable to sell or otherwise dispose of the vehicle (“unserviceable vehicle”); and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that the vehicle sought to be disposed of cannot be effectively used to benefit the County, and no substantial County or public purpose will be served in the future by this vehicle; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of Clayton County, and the County will best be served by disposing of the unserviceable vehicle at auction in accordance with applicable County Ordinance with the proceeds from said auction to be placed into the 221 account, city sharing.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

OF CLAYTON COUNTY, GEORGIA AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes Clayton County to accept title to a 2006 Suzuki GSX, MC, VIN #JS1GN7DA562116331; to authorize Clayton County to auction this unserviceable vehicle. The auction shall be conducted in a manner as will be in the best interest of the County, and in accordance with provisions of Section 2-147 of the Clayton County Code of Ordinances. The proceeds of the auction of this unserviceable vehicle shall be tendered to the County and placed into the 221 account, city sharing. The Directors of Central Service and Finance are authorized to perform all acts necessary to effect this resolution.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Board of Commissioners.
