RESOLUTION NO. 2012 - 187

A RESOLUTION TO ALLOW STATE SENATOR GAIL DAVENPORT TO HOST A TOWN HALL MEETING AT THE J. CHARLEY GRISWELL SENIOR CENTER; TO AUTHORIZE THE CHAIRMAN TO PERFORM ALL ACTS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Host wishes to utilize the Location in Jonesboro, Georgia on October 6, 2012, from approximately 3:00 p.m. until 6:00 p.m.; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners deems it in the best interest of the County and the County will best be served by allowing the Host to facilitate this meeting.

OF CLAYTON COUNTY AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED




